

Are You Performing a Detailed Room-by-Room ACCA Manual J Load Calculation to Ensure the HVAC System and Ductwork are Properly Sized and Designed?

ACCA Manual J and Manual D are the industry calculation standards (required by law) for proper equipment sizing, ductwork sizing, and air flow design for new and replacement Residential HVAC system installations. Manual J calculations take into account how many windows or entryways are in the building, how many people use each room and what other appliances in the building can produce or absorb heat. Mitchell Heating & Cooling's Detailed Room-by-Room calculation using a certified software (as mentioned in Question Two) meets or exceeds ACCA and ASHRAE* standards; to best determine the proper HVAC load requirements of your home to meet your family's specific comfort concerns.
